AFTERNOON NASHVILLE/BROWN COUNTY TRIP – FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 26

Nashville, Indiana is located in beautiful Brown County Indiana, just one hour south of Indianapolis, Indiana. For an entire century, generations of artists have recognized and celebrated Brown County, Indiana. In 1907, painter T.C. Steele first established residence in Brown County, with many of his friends and colleagues soon following his example.
